As usual Ronni did his normal excellent



offer. The owner from San Jose in America had shipped 4 Mustangs to Australia with his shipping agent, who were acting as sales agents for him. I spoke with the owner






of Global Auto Depot and came to an agreement on price.

The next day the Mach 1 arrived at its new home on the back of a flatbed truck. So 44 years later my dream had finally come true.


The car needs a little TLC and upgrading, but will be worth the effort.
